Frequently Asked Questions & Reservation Information

A Unique Opportunity

The 2028 Open Venues Experience has been created around three of the most iconic venues in modern Open Championship history:

- Royal Liverpool (Host Venue – The Open 2023)
- Royal Birkdale (Host Venue – The Open 2026)
- Royal Lytham & St Annes (Host Venue – The Open 2028)

Participation is limited to just 40 golfers, creating an intimate and memorable experience while ensuring access to some of the finest championship links golf in the world.

This is a rare opportunity to experience three recent Open Championship venues as part of one carefully curated golf journey, combining world-class golf, premium accommodation, organised social events and the camaraderie of travelling with fellow golfers who share a passion for the game.

EVENT OVERVIEW

What makes this event special?

This experience brings together three recent Open Championship host venues in a single itinerary, offering golfers the chance to play courses that have tested the world's best players on golf's biggest stage.

The event has been designed to combine exceptional championship golf with quality accommodation, organised social events and a relaxed group atmosphere.

How many golfers can attend?

Participation is limited to 40 golfers.

Will this event sell out?

We anticipate strong demand due to the unique nature of the itinerary and the limited number of places available. We recommend securing a place early.

Is the itinerary final?

The itinerary shown reflects the experience we fully expect to deliver. Final golf contracts and supplier agreements are anticipated to be completed during Spring 2027, at which point all details will be formally confirmed.

PRIORITY RESERVATIONS & DEPOSITS

Why are reservations opening before final confirmation?

Due to anticipated demand and the limited number of places available, we are accepting Priority Reservations ahead of final confirmation of all supplier contracts.

This allows golfers to secure their place while final arrangements are completed.

How much is the deposit?

A **\$2,500 deposit per golfer** is required to secure a Priority Reservation.

What does my deposit secure?

Your deposit secures priority access to one of the available places and reserves your position within the booking order.

When will the event be fully confirmed?

We expect final confirmation of golf contracts, accommodation arrangements and event pricing in Spring 2027.

What happens if the event cannot proceed as advertised?

Should circumstances arise that prevent the event from being delivered substantially as described once confirmations are received from suppliers in April 2027, customers will be offered appropriate alternatives, including a full refund of deposits paid.

PRICING & EXCHANGE RATES

How is the package priced?

This trip is priced using the current exchange rate of **£1 = \$1.33 USD** and is dependent on exchange rate movements leading into the trip.

The quoted price will remain valid provided the exchange rate remains between **£1 = \$1.28 USD and £1.38 USD**. If the exchange rate falls outside of this range, the trip will be repriced accordingly.

The final price may also be adjusted should any golf course, accommodation provider or supplier change their rates (higher or lower) between now and the trip.

Will the final price be confirmed before I am committed?

Yes.

Final event pricing will be confirmed once all golf, accommodation and supplier agreements have been finalised in Spring 2027.

Should the final package price increase, Priority Reservation holders will have 14 days from notification to cancel their reservation and receive a full refund of their deposit.

GROUPS & BOOKINGS

Can I travel as part of a group?

Absolutely.

We welcome groups of all sizes and expect many participants to travel as part of existing golfing groups, clubs and societies.

Can twosomes, foursomes and larger groups book together?

Yes.

Groups are welcome, subject to availability.

Will our group stay together?

Yes.

Groups travelling together will be accommodated together and paired together for golf throughout the event wherever possible.

Can a solo golfer attend?

Possibly.

We are happy to discuss enquiries from solo golfers. Availability for individual golfers will depend upon the overall composition of the field at the time of enquiry.

What happens if one golfer in our group can no longer attend?

Where possible, we encourage groups to identify a replacement golfer. Please contact us and we will work with you to determine the most suitable solution available at that time.

Can I transfer my reservation to another golfer?

In many circumstances this may be possible. Please contact us directly to discuss any proposed changes.

ACCOMMODATION

What type of accommodation is included?

Accommodation details will be confirmed as per the itinerary.

The event will feature carefully selected properties that reflect the quality and standard of the overall experience.

Can I have my own room?

Yes.

Single occupancy rooms will be available, subject to availability and the applicable single-room supplement.

NON-GOLFING PARTNERS

Can non-golfing partners attend?

Yes.

Non-golfing partners are welcome to join the event.

Will there be sightseeing options?

Depending upon final numbers and interest levels, additional sightseeing excursions and alternative activities will be available for non-golfing guests.

TRAVEL ARRANGEMENTS

Are flights included?

No.

Airfare is not included within the event package.

Are airport transfers included?

No.

However, transfer arrangements will be available upon request.

When should I book flights?

We recommend waiting until final event confirmation before making any flight arrangements.

WAITING LIST

What happens if the event reaches capacity?

Once all 40 places have been reserved, additional enquiries will be placed on a waiting list.

How does the waiting list work?

Places are offered strictly in the order waiting-list requests are received.

If a place becomes available, how long do I have to accept it?

Waiting-list applicants will typically have seven days to accept an offered place before it is offered to the next golfer on the list.

PAYMENT SCHEDULE

When is the balance due?

The remaining balance will be payable 120 days prior to departure.

Full payment details will be provided following final confirmation of the event.
